In the unlikely event it is proven that the "Property" is 1) not "original" and/or 2) not of clear title, payment made by Buyer to Seller will be reversed/refunded. Both Buyer and Seller have performed due diligence on this matter, in advance of this Agreement, in order to mitigate the possibility of any issues related to these contingencies.
